HIAWATHA COTTAGE BY THE BROOK LOVEDALE-OOTY

Hiawatha is an old English colonial cottage which is more than a 150-years-old house. It was owned by an English gentleman called Dr. Hope. It stands on $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre of property ensconced in the middle of Nilgiri hills and neighbours the oldest tribal family (TODAS). It is a 15-minute walk to Lawrence School and is approximately 5kms from the city centre.

This little piece of heaven is a paradise for birds and if you are lucky you may chance upon a deer, wild boar or even a Bison taking a stroll through the surrounding forest of the NILGIRIS (BLUE MOUNTAINS)

You will be greeted every morning by a little toy train made during the British Raj that toots along the outskirts of our cottage. Lovedale station being a 5-minute walk away. You could take a train ride into town or Coonoor

Lovedale is 7200 feet above mean sea level and is fairly warm in the summers and cool in the evenings.

Peace and tranquillity are the keys words that describe this pristine and rustic home.

This simple home is well furnished with a fully equipped kitchen. we have a live-in caretaker who will look after your requirements and make you feel at home and our dog Brandi will welcome you with a wag of her tail
